## Rules & Requirements

- Emergency Bag: Each time we leave the center for any outing we bring with us an emergency bag with supplies & contact information. If you have any items such as inhalers, medicine or health related items that your child will need on any outings please let a staff member know.
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray: We highly recommend that each child be sent with aerosol sunscreen & bug spray. Lotions are not accepted. We encourage Bull Frog Land Sport Continuous Spray (can be found on Amazon)
- Dress Code: Children are allowed to wear flip flops on the day we go to the pool, but in order to do any actives or field trips they MUST wear tennis shoes. Clothing should not promote violence or inappropriate subjects.
   Please dress child accordingly to the activity or field trip of each day.
- Food Allergies: If your child has any allergies or dietary restrictions please put it on their emergency form & let a staff member know.
- Lunches: In order to save space in our fridge, we will not be allowing the children to put their lunches in the refrigerator. Please send your children's lunch in an insulated lunch box except on field trip days. Due to the large number of children during the summer, microwaveable lunches are not permitted. There should be no glass containers, we suggest writing your child's name on any container/lid.
- Behavior: Children are expected to follow rules in order to keep pool, field trip & electronic/ home toy privileges.

The following are the classroom rules:
o Respect for self, others, learning & property
o No violence (hitting, kicking etc.) or threating
o No running indoors

o Respect for teachers & other adults
o Listen to guides on field trips & staying with the group
o Appropriate behavior in the van (No unbuckling, disturbing others,
getting out of the van before told & turning around in seat)
o Appropriate use of toys & outdoor equipment



Every Tuesday we will be taking a trip to Fairwood Swim Club from 10:30 – 11:30. The children are not only watched by our staff but also by the lifeguard on duty. On these day's children are required to come to FDN wearing their bathing suit under clothing/ cover-up. Spare clothing to change into after the pool should be in their bag. (shirt, shorts, underwear, socks & shoes) We strongly recommend, a wet bag for the children's wet suit & please remember a towel labeled with their name! FDN suggests that children wear swim shoes in the pool because the bottom is very coarse and can lead to scrapes. Children will not be allowed in the deep end of the pool unless the pass a lifeguard monitored swim test. If you wish to send your child with a floatation device, please be aware that only coast guard approved life vest are allowed at Fairwood Swim Club

• NOTE: Children's attendance to the pool is dependent on behavior at the pool, on the van & in the center.

Field Trips

On most Thursdays we require that your child wear tennis shoes & pack a Ziploc lunch.

NOTE: Children's attendance to field trips is dependent on behavior on the van & in the center.



During the summer we will be doing work, to keep the children's mind refreshed & ready for the upcoming grade they will be going into.

The work can vary between, language arts, math, reading, science & social studies.

There will be assigned groups of each grade, they will work together to complete their daily assignments.





For a small portion of the day the children will be reading together a series of books. We will be helping children with their public speaking as well as their reading comprehension.



The children will be starting to learn basics of a Spanish vocabulary. We believe that children at this age are the most absorbent to learn a secondary language. We will be having a new lesson every week, it will begin with the basics and by the end of summer we predict that children will be able to say complete sentences.
